

LOCAL COMMUNITIES PAY TRIBUTE TO PETER AND PAUL, PATRON SAINTS OF SAILORS AND FISHERMEN

Every 29 June, Cabo Blanco celebrates the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul. Among the traditions held, stands out sailing the revered images on board of a watercraft. This year, locals chose Inkaterra's iconic fishing boat 'Miss Texas' to sail Peter and Paul.
