

INKATERRA WORKS ON SUSTAINABLE FISHING

INKATERRA, committed to sustainable development, has acquired and restored the artisanal fishing boat 'Analúa', to pioneer good fishing practices in Cabo Blanco. The aim is to improve the quality of fish produced in this iconic cove, to allow artisanal fishermen into better markets and to get a higher income for good product, which shall improve their quality of life. 'Analúa' started its works last week with Mr. Eladio Ecca, local fisherman of Cabo Blanco, and a local crew.

The boat has been modified and equipped according to Mr. Ecca's specifications and soon its tests will be completed. Soon this ship will become a school-boat, which will allow Inkaterra to offer training courses on sustainable fishing on board. These will count with the support of experienced Japanese trainers, allowing artisanal fishermen to be ready to place in the market a top-notch product. In a near product, the tuna from Cabo Blanco will be exported with a certificate of origin.

Soon it will also have the gear for "Green-stick fishing", a new kind of fishing for Cabo Blanco, which shall have good results for tuna fishing. Breaking the world record on tuna, which was established at the Cabo Blanco Sea, is expected soon.
